TWO-DAY COMMITMENT

Vendor space is \$50 for each 10' x 10' space for the weekend of May 19-20, 2012, payable with application. Free camping for vendors. Amount may be paid by check, money order or by PayPal. There are no additional advertising costs. Festival will be held at Harmonizing Health Retreat or in the event of inclement weather, at the Bedford Community Center. Fee is non-refundable. *Make checks payable to Harmonizing Health Retreat*.

Exception: Submitting an application does not mean automatic acceptance. Festival will seek a balance of product and service variety and limited competition. If your categories have been filled, the fee will be returned in full.

To be included in bulk of advertising, applications must be received by April 1, 2012. Applications will be accepted after this date, depending on available space.

Conditions: Vendors are to be set up and ready by 9:30am Saturday and may not tear down until after 4:30pm on Sunday. If using a tent, vendor responsible for restoring ground where tent stakes are used. Security will be provided. The hosting organizations are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

Vendors are expected to keep vending area clean during and at breakdown on Sunday. No alcohol, drugs or firearms on premises. Language is expected to be suitable for families and children and respectful at all times.

Vending Space: Space will be assigned on a first come, first serve basis. There will be vending spaces in large circle around the Main Stage and in other areas on the grounds. A map of the spaces will be posted on the websites within a few weeks.

Camping: All camping is primitive with no hookups. Port-a-pots will be on site. You must provide your own tent and camping gear. You may bring food for yourself and those sharing your booth. There will be two food vendors, and water and fruit will be available to purchase. No vendor may sell food except those food vendors authorized to do so. Camping site is to be clean when free of trash and debris.
